A “Do More Attitude” and demonstrated leadership in student and community affairs, academic excellence (excluding the top student of the class), family income must meet (qualifiable income \$31,680.00), scholarship must be used within one year of graduation; scholarship will be made payable to the student and the school of choice upon proof of registration.

Father or Mother had to have graduated from Nixon (must be verified), must be in extracurricular activities for 4 years and GPA –B.

Pursue a medical career; essay of 750 minimum: “Why you want to pursue a career in the medical field?”

Applicant’s parent(s) or applicant <b>MUST</b> be member of LTFCU, any field of study, “B” average or better.	
<b>LAREDO GOLF ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP</b>	<b>\$400</b>
High school senior, golfer, 2 letters of recommendation from high school teachers.	
<b>LAREDO INTERNATIONAL FAIR &amp; EXPOSITION (L.I.F.E.)/ANA LAURA LOPEZ MEMORIAL</b>	<b>\$1,000</b>
Active member of Texas FFA, FHA, or 4H, must have competed in local LIFE Fair, ACT/SAT scores, rank preferably in upper 33% of class, must attend Texas college/university, preferred major-agriculture	

and or natural resources or consumer education.

<b>LAREDO NEXT GENERATION ROTARY CLUB/CLEMEN ROCHA-BELL SCHOLARSHIP FUND</b>	<b>\$300</b>
Must be a US citizen or legal permanent resident; enrolled as full time student at a college, university, or graduate School;( <b>NOT related to</b> a scholarship committee member, LULAC council president or contributor to LULAC funds.) A minimum of 10 hours of volunteer service; GPA of 3.0 or better; SAT or ACT scores and an <b>official transcript</b> .	
<b>LAREDO TENNIS ASSOCIATION</b>	<b>\$600</b>
Legal resident, enroll in college/junior college, letter of recommendation from Tennis Coach, acceptance letter, LTA volunteer hours, FAFSA report, and parent's W-@'s forms.	
<b>LAREDO U.T. EXES ASSOCIATION</b>	<b>Amount varies</b>
Academic success, extracurricular activities, and financial need. Must be already accepted to UT Austin.	
<b>L.I.S.D. POLICE OFFICER'S ASSOCIATION/CRIMINAL JUSTICE</b>	<b>Amount varies</b>
Criminal Justice student, essay min. 500 words on topic. Community involvement, 2.0 or above, letter of recommendation from Criminal Justice teacher	
<b>LEAD LAREDO</b>	<b>\$500</b>
Community hours; graduating in June 2017; good standing with all administration, attendance, and maintain a GPA of 90 average or higher. Complete Essay.	
<b>LOGISTICS &amp; MANUFACTURERS ASSOCIATION (Former Laredo Manufacturers Association)</b>	<b>\$1,000</b>
Any Texas college/university; must be resident of Laredo area; 3.0(B) GPA; <b>official transcript</b> .

Must be U.S. citizen or legal resident, community involvement, leadership activities, good grades, ACT or SAT scores, letter of acceptance from college/university, personal essay (no more than 300 words and essay must have student signature).	
<b>LULAC COUNCIL NO. 12 GENERAL AWARDS</b>	<b>\$500</b>
Must be U.S. citizen or legal resident, community involvement, leadership activities, good grades, ACT or SAT scores, letter of acceptance from college/university, personal essay (no more than 300 words and essay must have student signature).	
<b>LULAC COUNCIL NO. 624/CIS</b>	<b>\$500</b>
Must be U.S. citizen or legal resident, community involvement, leadership activities, good grades, ACT or SAT scores, letter of acceptance from college/university, personal essay (no more than 300 words and essay must have student signature).	
<b>McDONALD'S EMPLOYEE</b>	<b>\$500</b>
Open to employees who have been employed six months or more; must be a H.S. senior; GPA of 2.0 or higher; must be employed at time of scholarship announcement and graduation.	
<b>NORTH-EAST-WEST-SOUTH (NEWS) LAREDO HOOPS</b>	<b>Amount varies</b>
Must have participated in the NEWS tournament.	
<b>OUTSIDERS HOT ROD &amp; VINTAGE CAR CLUB</b>	<b>\$500</b>
Must be U.S. Citizen or legal resident, community involvement, leadership activities, good grades, ACT or SAT scores, letter of acceptance from college/university, personal essay (no more than 200 words and essay must have student signature) related to education, career, and future plans.

Must attend LCC or TAMIU, must be full time student (12 semester hours), and maintain a 2.0 GPA for academic year; (boys) must have played for Rio Grande Little League for one complete baseball season in the Major Division and in Junior and or Senior Division; (girls) must have also played one season in the Minors and or Major Division of the league. Girls can get credit for playing two seasons of organized softball at her designated high school, in lieu of playing in the Juniors or Seniors baseball division in the Rio Grande Little League.

<p>Graduating Senior, who has maintained a 2.5 GPA or higher, <b>must submit official transcript</b>, one letter of recommendation from teacher or counselor; family income less than \$50,000; have an immediate family member that is battling cancer or the loss of an immediate family member due to cancer in the past 3 years; a typed 2 page double spaced essay about yourself, your educational goals, and an event or person that impacted your life.</p>	
<b>ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY/SAN LUIS REY CHURCH/JORGE M. SANCHEZ MEMORIAL</b>	<b>\$500</b>
<p>Must attend San Luis Rey Church, involved in church related services; must be present members; be active in community related services; plan to attend LCC or TAMIU.</p>	
<b>TEENS IN THE DRIVERS SEAT</b>	<b>\$500</b>
<p>Graduating Junior or Senior; have participated in the 5K run; provide an <b>official school transcript</b>; one letter of recommendation from teacher; enroll at an accredited college or university for Fall 2017; 300-word essay on the following topic: "What would you do to promote safe teen driving, a healthy lifestyle, and staying in school?"</p>	
<b>THE LAREDO DAYBREAK ROTARY CLUB</b>	<b>\$1,000</b>
<p>Must be a graduate of a Laredo High School in the current Rotary year and planning to attend any university, or college. Scholarship will be valid for a twelve (12) month period.</p>	
<b>TUESDAY MUSIC AND LITERATURE CLUB (Rotational)</b>	<b>\$500</b>
<p>Be a resident of Laredo, Texas; maintain a B (80%) grade average or better; planning to attend a college or university of higher education in Laredo, Texas; two letters of recommendation from teacher; acceptance letter from LCC or TAMIU; scholarship must be used no later than the first semester; enroll in a minimum of 12 hours; and pursue a college degree in music or literature.</p>	
<b>VIETNAM VETERANS OF LAREDO ASSOCIATION</b>	<b>Amount varies</b>
<p>Father of Grandfather must have served in combat zone (Vietnam) (DD 214 Required); father and/or mother must have served in combat zone (Afghanistan and/or Iraq) during the Global War on Terrorism (DD 214 Required); good standing; letter of recommendation from counselor or teacher; <b>official transcript needed</b>.</p>	
<b>WEBB COUNTY BETTER COMMUNITY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP</b>	<b>Amount varies</b>
<p>College bound students with high achievements in academics and athletics as well as community involvement. Complete application along with a resume or essay.</p>	
<b>WEBB COUNTY C.A.A. HEADSTART</b>	<b>\$500</b>
<p>Former head-start enrollee (proof required), at least 2.0 GPA (attach an <b>official transcript</b>), need copy of income tax return, personal goal statement (200 words or less), list of all scholarships received with dates awarded.</p>	
<b>WEBB COUNTY HERITAGE FOUNDATION/ PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE RIO GRANDE</b>	<b>Amount varies</b>
<p>Applicant must be a candidate for graduation in June, 2017 from a high school located in Webb County, 1 page essay doubled-space on family history, letter of recommendation from teacher, counselor, or administrator.</p>
